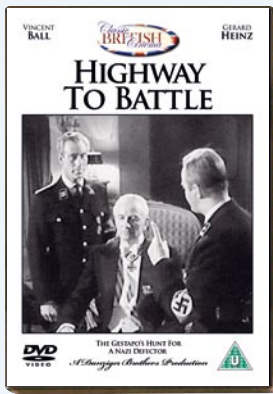

Drama, intrigue and espionage are at the very heart of this classic piece of British cinema.

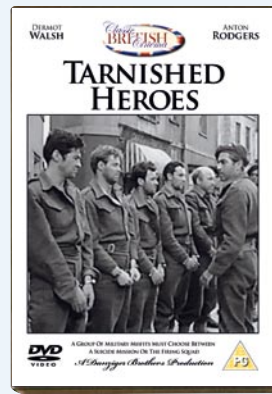
Set in London just months before the outbreak of World War Two, suspicion falls on a German ambassador when one of his envoys fails to return to Berlin.

TARNISHED HEROES

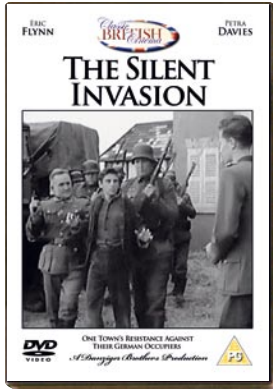

THE SILENT INVASION

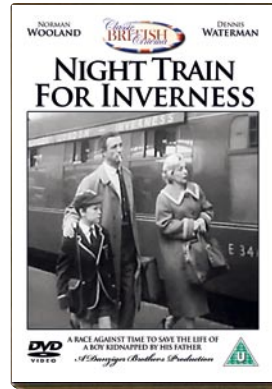

NIGHT TRAIN TO INVERNESS

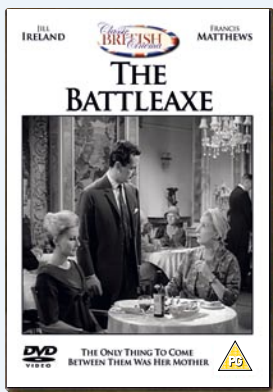

FATE TAKES A HAND

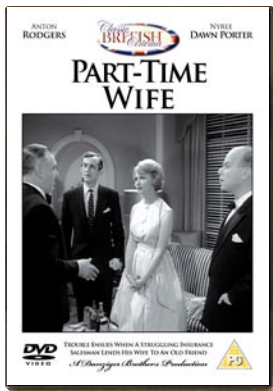

Tom is an unsuccessful insurance salesman with only one ray of sunshine in his life, his beautiful new bride Jenny.

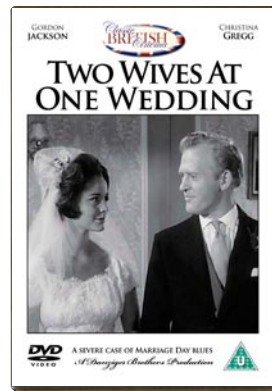

TWO WIVES AT ONE WEDDING

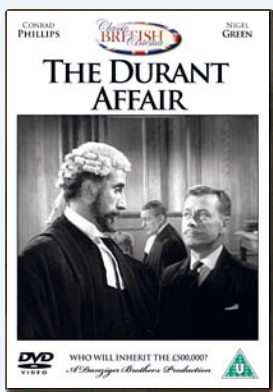

THE DURANT AFFAIR

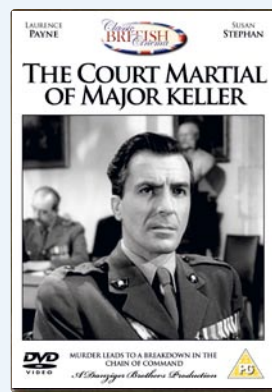

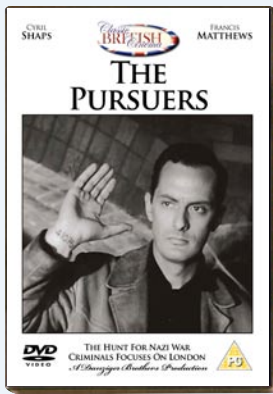

THE PURSUERS

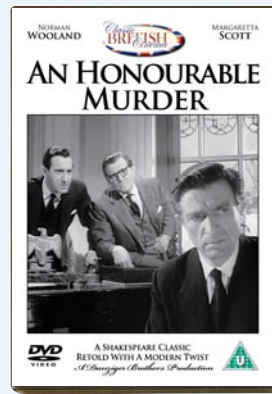

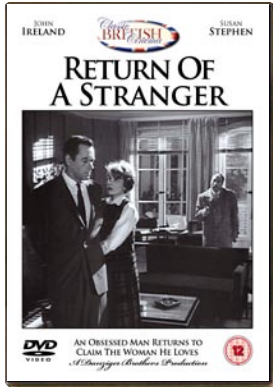

RETURN OF A STRANGER

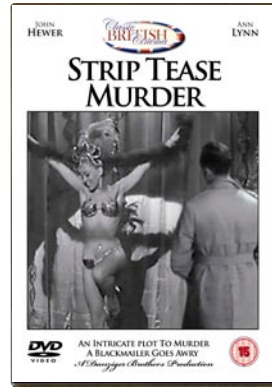
